The Leadership Institute Offerings:

Advising with Purpose

Alpha Gamma Deltas will learn techniques to advise and lead sisters through the Fraternity's values in a way that is relevant for them. The course focuses on identifying characteristics of millennial students and explores the best way to communicate with this generation. Core concerns and recommendations from "A Call for Values Congruence" will be discussed, in addition to techniques to develop a plan for putting organizational values into action.

Art of Balance

The art of finding balance is about accepting the things you have to do, spending time on the things you want to do and eliminating the things you feel you should do but aren't truly necessary. Alpha Gamma Deltas will identify the activities that consume the most time in their lives and develop plans to make the most effective use of their time.

Constructive Confrontation

This workshop will work to define confrontation and help sisters learn how to confront situations in a constructive and educational manner. Participants will learn appropriate non-verbal and verbal communication in each of the three confrontation styles and explore the six step confrontation model.

Managing Meeting Mishaps

The goal of this workshop is to help sisters understand the basics of meeting management and work to increase the leadership skills of participants. The facilitator will discuss how to follow a meeting agenda and the necessary steps to overcome difficulties that occur during the regular course of a meeting.
